St Monica, also known as Monica of Hippo, was an early Christian Saint (AD 322—387) and the mother of St Augustine of Hippo. She is remembered for her pious Christian virtues, especially in the face of her husband's adultery. (Some denominations disagree over the date of her festival.)

<i>Vidi aquam</i> is the Eastertide equivalent of <i>Asperges</i> . Each consists of sprinkling with holy water accompanied by an antiphon, a psalm verse, 'Glory be...' and the antiphon repeated. <i>Asperges</i> has the antiphon 'Thou shalt purge me...' and a verse of Ps. 51, 'Have mercy upon me, O God...' <i>Vidi aquam</i> has the antiphon 'I beheld water issuing out from the temple, on the right-hand side, and all to whom that water came were saved' and a verse of Ps. 118, 'O give thanks unto the Lord, for he is gracious, because his mercy endureth for ever.'
