



Community Engagement Officer – All Saints Church, North Street York

A vacancy has arisen for a Community Engagement Officer with heritage expertise due to the current post holder taking up a new appointment. The successful candidate will join a team delivering an exciting project to conserve and promote the world famous medieval stained glass windows at All Saints Church, North Street, York. This has been made possible through the awarding of a major grant from the National Lottery Heritage Fund. The appointee will build on the work of the outgoing Community Engagement Officer and will oversee the implementation of an ongoing activity programme to engage the wider public with the heritage of the building. The role will involve developing learning resources, volunteering, training, placements, partnerships, managing visits and marketing, including updating the website and social media.

The role is a part time (0.6/equivalent 3 days per week, two of which will be on site in York) fixed term contract ending June 2023.
